Afterschool/Extracurricular Activities  
Attendance Policy

In order to maintain safety and an academic focus on campus, the following policy will go into effect starting Wednesday, November 3rd, 2021.

If a student has been directly involved in any of the following behavior incidents for the 2021-22 school year, they will not be able to attend any after school extracurricular activities (festivals, sporting events, field trips, etc.) on campus or off-campus:

If a student has any of the following:

- Any Fs on progress reports or report cards
- Citizenship (Most recent marking period) - Unsatisfactory (U), Needs Improvement (N)

### **Attendance Application**

If a student would like to attend or participate in any upcoming afterschool/extracurricular activities or events, a [TMS Extracurricular Afterschool Activity Attendance Application](#) must be completed using the student's Google account.

Attendance will be limited to 300 students due to COVID-19 restrictions. If more than 300 students are interested in attending an event, a drawing will be conducted to determine who attends the event.

### **Appeal Process**

If a student is not eligible to attend, the decision may be reconsidered by the administrative team by completing the attendance application and the following:

Write one essay (1 page, typed, 12 pt font). Use Google Doc to answer the following questions:

1. What has caused you to not be eligible for attending or participating in an event or activity?
2. What was the consequence of the infraction, failing grade, or citizenship?
3. What did you learn from this experience?
4. What could you do differently next time to prevent an infraction, failing grade, or citizenship?

### **Appeal Submission and Review Process**

Submit the essay by email to Nancy Lager ([lagern@nv.ccsd.net](mailto:lagern@nv.ccsd.net)). Include in the subject line: Afterschool/Extracurricular Activity Essay. Once the essay has been received and reviewed, an administrator will schedule a meeting with you to discuss attending the event.
